

State Awards

Crystal Star Award

The Crystal Star Award is the highest chapter award. To be eligible the professional member must have preformed exemplary service to the chapter over many years, having potential local and national significance. The nomination must come from two state profession members. Board of Directors must approve.

Presidential Citation

The Presidential Citation is an award that is given to a member that has had an outstanding performance to the Chapter during that President's term. Chapter President determines award recipient.

Volunteer of the Year

The Volunteer of the Year is handed out to a committee member that has excelled in their role. Nominations must be given to a board member for a vote and approval.

National Awards

ASID Chapter Community Service Award

The ASID Chapter Community Service Award is bestowed by the Society upon an ASID professional chapter whose community service during the previous ASID program year best exemplifies, in the estimation of the judges, the spirit of bringing design to life in the service of others.

Chapter Educator Medalist Award

The ASID Chapter Educator Medalist Award is the highest award bestowed by ASID on Society members at the chapter level in recognition of outstanding service and significant contributions to their chapter and to the body of knowledge that supports the profession of interior design. Criteria include:

1. Outstanding and significant service to interior design education and/ or an ASID Chapter.
2. Significant local, regional or national contributions to interior design educations
3. Outstanding, significant and continued contributions that have enriched the human experience

Chapter Medalist

The ASID Chapter Medalist Award is the highest award bestowed by ASID on professional members at the chapter level in recognition of outstanding service and significant contributions to their chapter, the Society and the profession as a whole. Criteria are the following:

1. Outstanding and significant service to the chapter and the professional of interior design
2. Significant local, regional or national contributions to the interior design profession

3. Outstanding, significant and continued contributions that have enriched the human experience.

Designer of Distinction Award

The Designer of Distinction Award recognizes an ASID professional member who exemplifies a commitment to the profession as demonstrated by a significant, high quality body of work representing excellence in interior design. In addition, the nominee should show attention to social concerns within the interior design profession and express creative, innovative concepts that have advanced the profession.

Design for Humanity Award

The Design for Humanity Award is bestowed by the Society upon an individual or institution that has significantly contributed to improving the environment for humanity through design related activities or projects. The impact of these activities must have demonstrated far reaching effects.

Educator of Distinction Award

The Educator of Distinction Award recognizes an individual, institution, or research project that is seminal to the body of knowledge that supports the profession of interior design. To be given on an annual basis as merited.

Fellowship

Fellowship is the highest honor that ASID bestows on its members. Elevation to fellowship not only recognizes that achievements of an individual designer but also elevate before the public and the profession a model interior designer who has made a significant contribution to the profession and the Society. Criteria are the following:

1. Promote the excellence and advancement of interior design
2. Enhance the profession of interior design by advancing the education, training and/ or practice of interior design
3. Provide leadership to the interior design industry and the profession of interior design
4. Ensure the advancement of human living standards by improving interior environments, making the profession an ever-increasing social service
5. Preserve the health, safety, and welfare of the public

Honorary Fellowship

Honorary fellowship is the highest honor that ASID can bestow on an individual who is not an interior designer by profession. Honorary fellowship is granted to individuals who have shown achievement on a national or international level in the areas related to design, and those who have made noteworthy contributions to the advancement of the interior design profession. Honorary fellowship may be granted to individuals who have shown distinction fulfilling the criteria established by the ASID Council of Fellows. Criteria are the following:

1. Promote advancement of excellence in interior design
2. Enhance the profession through education, training and/ or design practice
3. Provide leadership to the industry and profession of interior design

4. Preserve the health, safety and welfare of the public
5. Champion the profession of interior design through significant endowment to vital professional initiatives

Honorary Chapter Medalist Award

The ASID Honorary Chapter Medalist Award is the highest chapter award bestowed by the Society upon ASID non-practitioners at the chapter level, in recognition of their outstanding service and significant contributions to an ASID chapter, to the Society and to the overall profession of interior design. Criteria are the following:

1. Outstanding and significant service to the profession of interior design and/ or and ASID Chapter
2. Significant local, regional or national contributions to the interior design profession
3. Outstanding, significant, and continued contributions that have enriched the human experience

Industry Partner Merit Award

The Industry Partner Merit Award is the highest award that ASID bestows on an Industry Partner representative. Criteria are based on the following:

1. Outstanding and significant service to their chapter and the profession
2. Exemplary service to their chapter and conspicuous contribution to the profession, having potential local, regional and/ or national significance
3. Contributions at the chapter level, of such importance that they have significantly enhanced the chapter and the profession
4. Significant participation in chapter activities and outstanding contributions which have enriched the human experience

Life Membership

Life membership is an honor recognizing individual members for their special contributions to ASID. The membership status is confined to past ASID Society-level presidents and other professional members who qualify within the eligibility guidelines.

Patrons Prize

The Patron's Prize honors those who support and/ or promote quality interior design, and is given on an annual basis as merited.

Product Prize

The Product Prize recognizes an individual, organization or manufacture that has contributed a significant and lasting body of work related to the products of interior design. Multiply awards may be given annually as merited, in corporate and individual categories.
